This World Wide Web site, www.kids-printables.co.uk, ("the Site") is operated by Widdlykinks.com Ltd (Widdlykinks.com), a Company incorporated in England (registered number 05728870), and having its registered office at 2nd Floor, 145-157 St. John Street, London, EC1V 4PY, United Kingdom with a Scottish mailing address of Suite 163, 98 Woodlands Road, Glasgow, G3 6HB.

Privacy

Widdlykinks.com is committed to protecting your privacy. Accordingly, Widdlykinks.com shall process personal data that you submit to Widdlykinks.com through the Site in accordance with Widdlykinks.com Privacy Statement. 1. Use of Data

1.1 In this Privacy Statement, Personal Data means any information and data about you that you provide in the course of your use of this World Wide Web Site (the "Site").

1.2 Widdlykinks.com will store and use Personal Data in accordance with UK Data Protection Laws.

1.3 Personal Data may be used by Widdlykinks.com for the following purposes:

- A. To assist Widdlykinks.com in providing services to you, and subsequently to allow Widdlykinks.com to collect payment for such services;
- B. For market analysis and product development by Widdlykinks.com;
- C. For direct marketing to you by way of email, telephone, fax, text and/or letter;
- D. For credit scoring, credit assessment, debt tracing or fraud and money-laundering prevention;
- E. For any express purpose stated in the page where you entered the Personal Data; and
- F. Any other purpose in relation to which you have given your explicit consent.
- G. Information may also be given to third parties who Widdlykinks.com feel may be able to provide you with further products and or services that may be beneficial or may be of interest to you.

2. Disclosure of Data

2.1 In order to achieve the purposes set out in section 1.3 above Widdlykinks.com may disclose the Personal Data as follows:-

- A. To employees and agents of Widdlykinks.com;
- B. To its subsidiaries (where the term "subsidiary" has the meaning set out in the UK Companies Act 1985);
- C. To suppliers of Widdlykinks.com who are contracted to provide any support or administration, facilities management or similar services to Widdlykinks.com;
- D. To credit reference agencies or other credit assessment, debt tracing or fraud prevention organisations; and
- E. To any company or organisation to which Widdlykinks.com transfers all, or a substantial part, of its assets and undertakings.
- F. To third parties who Widdlykinks.com feel may be able to provide you with further products and or services that may be beneficial or may be of interest to you.

2.2 In addition, Widdlykinks.com may disclose Personal Data to third parties where required by law.

3. Transfers of Personal Data

3.1 In order to achieve the above purposes Widdlykinks.com may need to i) transmit the Personal Data using the Internet and/or

ii) transfer the Personal Data outside the European Economic Area (the "EEA"). In such circumstances Widdlykinks.com will use reasonable endeavours to ensure that such Personal Data is adequately protected from unauthorised access. Note also that where Personal Data is transmitted using the Internet all or part of the Personal Data may be transmitted or routed through territories outside the EEA.

3.2 The Internet is inherently insecure and Personal Data submitted by means of the Internet may be vulnerable to unauthorised access by third parties. Submission of Personal Data using the Internet is at your own risk.

4. Subsequent Communications

4.1 Any telephone calls and/or Emails to/from Widdlykinks.com which you make/receive/send may be monitored and recorded for the purposes set out in section 1.3 above and/or i) security purposes; ii) legal purposes; and/or iii) quality control purposes.

5. No Other Use Without Consent

5.1 Other than as expressly set out in sections 1, 2, 3 and 4 of this Privacy Statement Widdlykinks.com will not use, actively disclose or transfer the Personal Data without your explicit consent.

6. Subject Access Rights

6.1 Under UK Data Protection law, you are entitled to receive a copy of information or data about you that is held by Widdlykinks.com upon payment of a fee (currently £10). You are also entitled to require the rectification, erasure or blocking of any such information or data which is inaccurate or not up-to-date and held by Widdlykinks.com. You may also require that Widdlykinks.com cease to process any such information or data that is likely to cause you substantial damage or substantial distress. If you wish to exercise any of these statutory rights, or if you wish to opt-out of any future processing of your information or data held by Widdlykinks.com, please write to Widdlykinks.com at its Scottish postal address detailed at the top of this Privacy Statement stating your name and address and providing Widdlykinks.com with any relevant information.

7. Non Personal Data

7.1 In some cases, Widdlykinks.com may collect information about you that is not Personal Data. Examples of this type of information include the type of Internet browser you are using, the type of computer operating system you are using, and the domain name of the web site from which you linked to the Site.

8. Registry

You agree that we may transmit data to your computer to store by means of cookies on your system. If you decide to register with the Telephone Preference Service or Fax Preference Service in the UK, or any equivalent, you agree to tell us before such action, so that we can update our records accordingly and exclude you from any such marketing.

9. Payment

Our credit card agency (PROTX) is external to our site, and therefore you will be protected by their privacy policy and security arrangements when you enter your payment details on their site.
